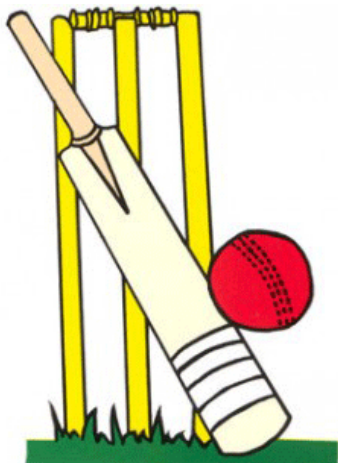

Please drop off any clean, no longer needed items of kit to the office.



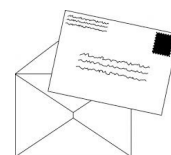

Level 4 - Write a letter to the Chair of Governors - Mr Jason Wolfe - requesting a Governors' complaint panel to hear your complaint.

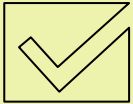

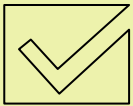

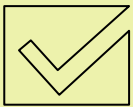
