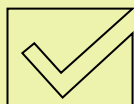
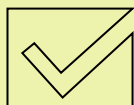
We have managed to recruit some 'Reading' volunteers - thank you to all new and existing 'Reading' volunteers.

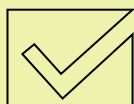
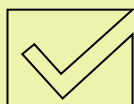

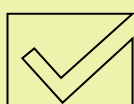
