### **Parking points**

If driving children to school, please remember the following:

**Do not** use the car park - only cars with a disability badge are entitled to use the school car park

**Do not** park on the zig zag lines – this provides visibility outside the gates

**Do not** park on corners – it is against the law to park within 10 m of a junction

**Do not** park across drives or opposite the steep sloping drives outside the church – be considerate to residents

**Do** park a bit further away and give the children some exercise, and if at all possible, **do** let children walk/cycle/scoot/skip/dance etc to school!


