This will be a lovely opportunity for...

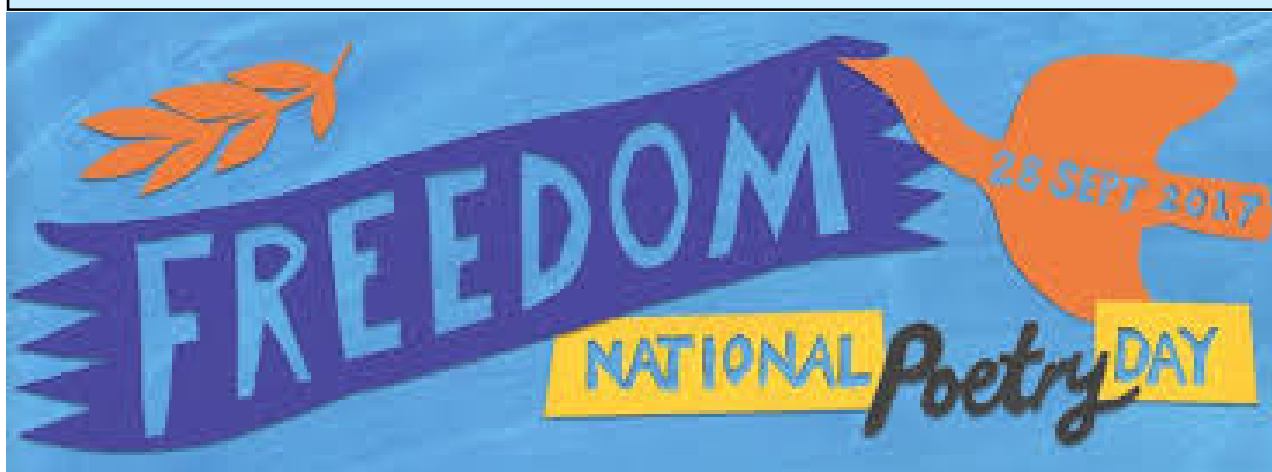
